# About Us

Peter Francis Enterprises Limited is a Nigerian agro-based export-oriented company dedicated to connecting international markets with high-demand Nigerian agricultural products. Registered with the Nigerian Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) and the Nigerian Export Promotion Council (NEPC), the company aims to act either as farmers or export merchants by sourcing or cultivating export-quality crops. Leveraging technology and strategic partnerships with local farmers, the company buys goods at lower local currency rates and sells to global buyers in foreign currencies, primarily US dollars. With Nigerian government support through duty-free policies and export grants, the company plans to expand by securing export contracts via global business portals, creating an online presence through a functional website, and using targeted advertising.

The export process begins with opening a domiciliary account, sourcing verified contracts, and negotiating terms including pricing, packaging, shipping, and payment. Upon agreement, samples are sent, and once approved, a Pro-Forma Invoice is issued. A Letter of Credit or other payment method initiates procurement, followed by quality testing and documentation (e.g., CCI, certificates of origin/health). The products are then transported, inspected by Customs, and shipped. The exporter ensures repatriation of proceeds within 180 days, enabling access to a 5% Federal Government export grant. This structured and strategic approach positions the company to thrive in global agricultural trade.
